


#### WHO WE ARE

#### RESEARCH LIBRARY

The RICIGS library collection is housed at the Rock Island County Historical Society, 822 12th Avenue, Moline, IL. Our library includes over 2,000 books and periodicals spanning from colonial times to the present, covering every region of the U.S. Members may use these items for free.

#### **OUR WEBSITE**

#### **MEETINGS**

Meetings are held at 6:30 p.m. at the Butterworth Education Center, 701 12th Avenue, Moline, IL on the fourth Tuesday of the month, January through October. The annual dinner meeting is held in November. There is not a meeting in December.

#### **OUARTERLY**

Members receive a printed hard copy quarterly that is published and mailed in spring and fall of each year. In addition, members will receive an electronic newsletter via email in winter and summer.

#### **PUBLICATIONS/CDS**

The Society has several publications and genealogical forms available for purchase. Also available are CDs containing cemetery records and genealogical newspaper abstracts. Details about purchasing these items are on our website.

#### RESEARCH/QUERIES

RICIGS will do research for you! The cost is \$10 per hour prepaid – 1 hour minimum – 3 hour maximum. Queries are put in the quarterly free for members. Queries cost \$2 for non-members and are limited to 50 words.
