

Ada Jamieson Lound



Ada Jamieson was born in Moline on June 15, 1869, the daughter of Norah H. and Alexander W. Jamieson. She graduated from high school in 1890 and taught school for two years. She married William G. Lound on September 28, 1892.

She had two sons, Chester Douglas Lound and Ralph Sherman Lound.

She was a member of Wesley Methodist church.

She died December 4, 1925.

Blanche Jamieson

Blanche was born July 25, 1871 in Moline, Illinois, daughter of Alexander and Norah Helen Jamieson. Blanche never married. She attended the Augustana Business College and started work as a Stenographer for Deere & Company about 1892.

When her mother Norah Helen moved from Ann Arbor, Michigan back to Moline in about 1911, she and Blanche lived together at 1812-16th Street. She was active in the First Baptist Church, Moline, the Moline Women's Christian Temperance Union, King's Daughters and Moline Women's Club.

Family letters in 1949 relate that Blanche was acting strangely. She was admitted to the East Moline State Hospital on June 16, 1949 and died there 2 months and 25 days later.
