



The Blackhawk Genealogical Society Board met January 9, 1992 at 6p.m. at the Rock Island Library with 8 members present.

President Louise Davis called the meeting to order and thanked Zelma Hendricks for her work the past two years.

The minutes from the November 14th Board meeting were read and approved.

President Davis read correspondence from Janet Greenlee of the Quad City Genealogical Conference Committee planning the April 4th conference of Blackhawk and Scott Societies.
