



January 14, 1993

The Blackhawk Genealogical Society Board met January 14, 1993 at the Rock Island Library at 6p.m. with 9 members present. President Davis called the meeting to order.

The minutes were read from the November 11th, 1992 board meeting by the secretary. They were approved as read.

Treasurer Patti Doonan reported a balance of \$12,660.46 on December 31, 1992 with monthly income of \$334.34 and disbursements \$222.00. Income for the year of 1992 was \$7,789.71 and disbursements were \$7,596.64. This will be filed for audit.

Correspondence was read by President Davis. This included a thank you from Howard MacIntosh's family for the memorial in his name. And a letter from the Illinois Genealogical Society that the state owned genealogical collection housed at the Shawnee Library in Carterville, IL is being given away to a private library. They were calling for action from all genealogical societies. Patti Doonan will call our state senator and representative with a protest.

It was decided to reserve 3 tables this year at our genealogical conference in April.

Old Business - The budget & auditing committee will meet to audit the society's books and set the 1993 budget on January 22nd, 1993 at Dean Ring's house at 11:00a.m.

New Business - Pam Langston reported that Charlotte Blevins will hold a 2 part, 8 session genealogical workshop in February and April at the Rock Island County Historical Society.

The Heritage Society sent notice of a program at the Putnam Museum on February 7th from 2-4p.m on "Preserving Cherished Photos & Family Documents."

Vice-President Virginia Horton has arranged this year's dates for meetings at South Park Presbyterian Church at 7p.m. They are: January 26; March 23; April 27; May 25; June 22; July 27; August 24; September 28; October 26; and our annual dinner meeting November 16. Programs will be: January 26, Copying Old Photos; February 23 we will meet at the new Rock Island County Historical Library for a tour; March 23, Dick Liebowitz on county records; April 17, Annual Genealogical Conference; April 27, Pat Riley Groves of Rochelle will talk on the State Historical Library in Madison, WS.

Dorothy Darland will start bring back issues of our society's quarterly's to meetings to sell as well as back issues of other society's quarterlys to give away as we need to start emptying

our collection at the Beling Building. It was suggested that we donate a copy of each of our past quarterlys to the Rock Island County Historical Library.


